for victims of hate crimes, especially anti-Semitism

- » Take advantage of the assistance offered by counseling centers and the police.
- » It is only with your help that we will be able to solve the crime completely, hold the offenders accountable and as a result protect others from such crimes. Dealing openly with what you have experienced is a first step in taking action against right-wing extremism, racism, anti-Semitism and all forms of hate crime.
- » If you are faced with a significant threat, you may, in the course of an investigation or criminal proceedings, provide an address other than your own. This may be necessary, for example, when someone is threatening you with violence because you want to testify in legal proceedings. In such cases, you may provide a different address you can be reached at, such as the address of a victim support service you are in contact with.
- » In case of an emergency, call the police immediately by dialing the emergency number 110.
